It is the responsibility of every competitor and visitor to fully comply with the UK Hoopers rule book and additional even guidance at all times, that means you must take the time to learn the rules yourself.

Dogs are welcome to participate in both events and will be subject to the relevant rules and regulations for each sport. It is the handlers responsibility to ensure only a suitable level of activity for each dog is undertaken and to present to entered classes when required. Key information for this event:

- 1 outdoor ring
- Classes expect to run in order
- First course walking after 9am, judging starts 9.30am
- Each class will close as soon as there are no more dogs on the line after we have called all remaining dogs
- It is the handlers responsibility to be at the ring ready to run at the correct time
- Prizegiving is likely to be after all classes have finished, however there may be a prizegiving mid way
- The judge may break for lunch
- Please ensure that you drive slowly in all parts of the venue and courteously through the local area



Ring Layout

There will be 1 ring set up and classes will follow the attached running order. There will be announcements to let you know when the ring becomes open for walking so listen out for these. Please ensure you have walked your course before the judging commencement time as once judging starts there will be no further walking.

There will be at least 10 minutes to walk each course.

You must not touch anything inside the ring.

We encourage you to maintain social distancing *at all times*, including when walking courses, you are also responsible for making sure that everyone else is able to maintain social distancing from you too.

Course Walking

There will be a white board on the fence of the ring, this will contain extra course info and also tell you about any PowerPoints that course may contain. It will also detail the coloured running order for the class/day. It will remain the same for every class in that ring for that day so taking a photo as a reminder can be helpful. There will be announcements through the day of what colours are running in the ring. You can also find ring updates on hoopers.online results.

Timetable

The proposed timetable is as follows, please note that it is your responsibility to ensure you have walked your courses and are available to run, those with multiple dogs are asked to ensure that they remain on the ball so that the ring is not waiting for people to swap dogs. The ring will not be held.

The show opens for parking at 7.30am and access to the arena and course walking from 9am. Judging will begin at 9.30am.

Yellow Dogs

Dog requiring extra space are collectively referred to as Yellow Dogs (please see www.yellowdoguk.co.uk for more). UK Hoopers are committed to providing a low stress, low arousal environment to help dogs become conditioned to sports competitions. If your dog requires extra space please ensure you tick the YELLOW DOG box on their hoopers.online profile. Yellow dogs queue separately to other dogs to allow everyone to help cater for their needs, they often run either first or last in a class. If you have a Yellow Dog you MUST wear an identifying yellow garment AT ALL TIMES around the showground — people won't be able to give you space unless they can identify that you need it. We implore all handlers to read the rule book carefully and provide additional space to dogs wearing yellow. Please note that it is not possible to create an entirely dog/person free environment at a competition and competitors are reminded to consider that there will be other dogs/people present at all times. Fenced Rings

Rings will be fenced on 3 ½ sides at this event with an open entry and exit chute.

Please remember that rings are fenced to provide a clear visual boundary, not to contain dogs, or as a substitute for appropriate training. It is your responsibility to ensure your dog is suitably trained to remain in the ring when competing.

Scoring:

Live scoring will be used, you can check your results at https://hoopers.online throughout the day. If using a mobile phone you can opt to save the page directly to your home screen for easy access. Simply tap the 3 dots and select "Add to Home Screen" which will put the icon on your phone screen.

Competitors must:

- Be ready to run before they enter the ring (coats, jackets, bumbags etc removed)
- Loudly and clearly give your **dog's name first** and then your name to the scorer as you make your way to the start.
 - Please wait for the scorer to acknowledge they have the correct dog on the tablet and then wait to be started by the scorer / judge. This only takes a few seconds so at this point you should already be on the start line ready to run immediately, not still at the edge of the ring with your dog on the lead.
- Thank you judge on their way out of the ring
- Not gather around ring entrances/exits or thoroughfares etc and please ensure that you follow the UK Hoopers rules on being 2m from the ring fence at all times.
- Be present to collect awards and prizes at prizegiving otherwise they will be forfeited.

Exercise Area

The exercise area is shared with the agility show. Please follow the rules as asked by the show. Please ensure that all waste is picked up, bagged up and deposited in the bins provided.

Food & Drink:

There are various hot and cold food vans at the agility show.

Hoopers Record of Achievement Books will be available to purchase on site at £5 each from the show office.

Lastly, and this is the most important rule of all. Have fun! Smile! Enjoy your day with your dog, praise them even if it all goes wrong and laugh it off and don't forget to thank your judge for giving up their day so that we can enjoy ours. We are very much looking forward to seeing everyone, drive safe and see you soon!
