Class Descriptions

Hoopers – A course consisting only of hoops.

Parcours – A course containing any combination of allowable equipment.

Speedstakes – A fast and flowing, uncomplicated course designed to test speed and accuracy. Speedstakes is an open class and is open to all registered dogs

Grading

All standard classes have separate awards for Small, Large and Veteran dogs (Veteran & Veteran+ will be split if numbers allow). **Open** classes have 1 set of awards per class but will usually place to a higher number. **Combined** – both grades of dog will compete together with results split into Small, Large and Veteran. **Graded**– Separate awards for each section in each grade (Eg. G1 Small, G1 Large, G1 Veteran, G2 Small, G2 Large, G2 Veteran and so on)

Classes labelled with only one grade are graded classes which are open to dogs of that grade only.

Please ensure you check your entry and select classes carefully, refunds will not be provided for entries into classes for which you are not eligible to run in.

NFC runs are available. A handler may choose to run NFC (Not for Competition) in any class in which they are eligible to compete. The handler must inform the scribe/judge upon entering the ring before commencing their run. The handler then has 60 seconds ring time and may train in the ring. **NFA** (Not for Award) runs are also available, please see rules for further details. A silent toy may be carried in the hand when running in Grade 1, NFC or Nursery & Legends

Yellow Dogs

Dog requiring extra space are collectively referred to as Yellow Dogs (please see <u>www.yellowdoguk.co.uk</u> for more). UK Hoopers are committed to providing a low stress, low arousal environment to help dogs become conditioned to sports competitions. If your dog requires extra space please ensure you tick the YELLOW DOG box on their hoopers.online profile. Yellow dogs queue separately to other dogs to allow everyone to help cater for their needs, they often run either first or last in a class. If you have a Yellow Dog you **MUST** wear an identifying yellow garment **AT ALL TIMES** around the showground – people won't be able to give you space unless they can identify that you need it. We implore all handlers to read the rule book carefully and provide additional space to dogs wearing yellow. Please note that it is not possible to create an entirely dog/person free environment at a competition and competitors are reminded to consider that there will be other dogs/people present at all times. Fenced Rings

At UK Hoopers shows, rings are fenced on 3 ½ sides with an open entry and exit chute. Further to this, rings that join onto another, with a shared boundary, have an additional layer of fencing to create an enhanced visual barrier.

At this special beginners show we will also provide an additional, closable barrier to the entry and exit chutes to provide a fully fenced ring for the confidence of beginner dogs and handlers. Please remember that rings are fenced to provide a clear visual boundary, not to contain dogs, or as a substitute for appropriate training. It is your responsibility to ensure your dog is suitably trained to remain in the ring when competing.

Dog Section

Small – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15cm or less.

Large – Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15.1cm or more.

Veteran – Dogs 7-10 yrs. **Veteran+** - Dogs 10yrs or over. (Dogs may run as a Veteran or not at the handlers choice. Once a dog competes as a Veteran they will remain as such).

Awards

All classes will place with rosettes to a minimum of 3rd place or to 20% of pre entries, whichever is higher. Clear Round rosettes will be available for unplaced, clear rounds (unplaced means no placing rosette is awarded). Prizes or trophies may be awarded based on pre-entered class numbers. Presentations will be made during the show, all awards must be collected before the show closes or shall be forfeited.

Full Rulebook

Can be viewed at www.ukhoopers.com competitors must read and understand the rules before entering and will be expected to comply at all times. The judges decision is final.

Online Entries, Info & Scoring

Schedule and entries will be available via <u>https://hoopers.online</u>

Entries will close on the date advertised or if the entry cap is reached, whichever is soonest. Amendments after this date will not be possible.

Online scoring will be used at this show. You can check results at hoopers.online any errors, omissions or queries must be raised within 10 minutes of the class closing and all results being input. Competitors must not approach a judge during a class to discuss your score, please consult the rulebook before attending which details scoring, allocation of faults and progression.

Some classes (such as pairs) may be run **PAY ON THE DAY** you will register and enter these classes at the show office on the day.

Webster Novice Championship Qualifier

This class will count as one heat of the qualifying rounds and there are multiple qualifying heats throughout 2023.

The three highest placed dogs, in Grade 1, in all sections, instantly qualify for the finals. Points will be awarded to all other placings and clear rounds. Dogs placed in the top three placings through the heats will be invited to the final in July, remaining finalists will be drawn from the points table.

Only grade 1 dogs may qualify for the finals. Any dogs who may have qualified whilst Grade 1 but since graded up into grade 2 will still be invited to run in the finals. This tournament is kindly sponsored by Websters

Food & Drink:

A range of hot and cold food and drinks will be available from Fatknacks Diner during breakfast and lunch. Classic cooked breakfast items from rolls to full English including vegetarian options and hot and cold lunches, salads, wraps, burgers, jacket potatoes and more at very reasonable prices.

Camping:

Camping is available Thursday, Friday, Saturday at the normal rate of £25 for the weekend. Please note, it is not possible to book camping for individual nights, camping is only available as a weekend block. No late camping will be accepted.

Water is available and there is a toilet emptying point. There is no hook-up or showers. Generators are permitted between 8am and 8pm please position them with consideration of your neighbours.

- Only Park where directed.
- All units must carry a fire extinguisher or have a bucket of water at the front of the unit at all times.
- Training equipment is not allowed to be used on site.
- <u>No Fires or firepits.</u> BBQ's must be off the ground (BBQ may be prohibited subject to ground conditions)
- Arrivals strictly after 4pm Thursday. NO arrivals before this time.
- No arrivals after 9pm any evening.

Directions to the Venue

Croxton Kerrial is on the A607 between Melton Mowbray and Grantham. The postcode brings you to Middle Street, if you are coming up hill (From Melton Mowbray/A46) this is the 2nd LEFT. If you are coming downhill from Grantham (A1/A52) this is the 2nd RIGHT.

Follow MIDDLE STREET all the way along, you will pass the Church (on your right hand side) and just after the church is a LEFT HAND BEND, the entrance is immediately after this bend, please indicate RIGHT as you approach the bend and turn up the driveway between 2 hedges. There will be a cone or a sign marking the entrance also.

Local Amenities

There is a pub in the village which serves home cooked food, the pub is dog friendly and they also have a small number of B&B rooms available (also dog friendly). There are 2 Travelodge's within 20 minutes at Grantham and Colsterworth and lots of other local accommodation.

We have a fabulous shop in the village for essentials (including home made cakes, fresh coffee and locally made ice cream!), also the village store in Knipton (the next village) sells Calor gas.

Exercise Area

There is an off lead exercise area in the small paddock next to the show field. Entry is via the hand gate under the tree from day parking. Only 2 off lead dogs per person during show times, all poo must be bagged and removed. Do not use/move equipment and do not allow dogs to pee on equipment, fencing or furniture. **Poo bags (and all other rubbish) must be disposed of in black bags onlye, not in any other bin. Dogs must not be exercised in the play park and the bin in the park MUST NOT BE USED.**

There are also some really lovely local walks accessible directly from the show field. All dog waste must be picked up immediately, failure to do some will result in removal from the event.

Recycling

Please place CLEAN recycling in the GREEN bags, This includes paper, card, glass and tin. No poo bags, food wrappers, plastic wrapping or general rubbish in these bins. Please help us to do our bit for the environment by using the correct bins for your rubbish.
