SPECIAL BEGINNERS COMPETITION

What Is It?

Beginners are ALWAYS welcome at our events, however we know that attending your first show can be a bit daunting so on **Saturday 10th May** we're throwing the doors wide open and inviting handlers to come and try their first UK Hoopers competition, with a little extra help from us.

Who Is It For?

There are classes for all grades of dog, it's not just for beginners. However, we'll have some extra help in place for those attending their first show or who are still quite new to competing. Of course, you're welcome to join us for the entire weekend.

What Can I enter?

If you've competed with us before then enter as you normally would. If you haven't competed with us before, but have progressed elsewhere then you should follow the guidance in the Competition Handbook to make sure you're entering the correct grade.

If you haven't competed with us, or anywhere else before, or if you've only done a very small number of shows then here's what we'd recommend... If you're ready to take on the course you can enter Grade 1, these are class numbers 21 & 24 for Parcours. and 26 & 29 for Hoopers. You are welcome to enter all 4 of these if you wish. They'll be flowing at set at beginner level. If you're not quite ready for full competition courses, or want to run for clear rounds over a lovely pre-competition level course, you should try Nursery & Legends instead, Nursery and Legends can be entered by any dog over 12 months and are class numbers 22 and 29. You **can't** run in a mixture of Grade 1 and Nursery & Legend classes.

There is also a Special Beginners Speedstakes class, this is a special class, just for fun and you can enter this in addition to either Grade 1 or N&L classes.

CLASSES, GRADES & QUALIFIERS

Class Description

Hoopers: A course using only hoops (Progression)

Parcours: A course using any combination of allowable equipment

(Progression)


Speedstakes: A fast and flowing course designed to test accuracy (Special)

Pairs: 2 dogs, 2 handlers negotiate the course for a single score & combined

time (Special)

Stop the Clock: A smooth course where you choose how many obstacles to complete before stopping the clock, the aim is to get as close to the time set by the judge as possible (Games).

Nursery & Legends: An uncomplicated, smaller scale course set at Pre Competition to Grade 1 level. For dogs of any age above 12 months, adult dogs of any grade can run N&L courses by choice.

CLASSES, GRADES, RESULTS & AWARDS

Class Grades & Awards

Each class is either Graded, Combined or Open for the purpose of awards.

Open: All dogs compete against each other with one set of awards.

Combined: Different grades may compete together and awards are split

into Small, Large and Veteran

Graded: Each Grade is split individually into Small, Large and Veteran

Dog Section

Small: Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15cm or less.

Large: Dogs with an ulna measurement of 15.1cm or more.

Veteran: Dogs 7-10 yrs. Veteran+: Dogs 10yrs or over. Veteran and

Veteran+ results are combined. (Dogs may run as a Veteran or not at the handlers choice. Once a dog competes as a Veteran they will remain as

such).

- Placing to 20% of pre entry beyond 3rd place

- Trophies/Prizes dependant on pre entry numbers

QUALIFIERS FOR 2024 FINALS

All qualifiers are open to all registered dogs who meet the eligibility criteria of that heat.

Naylor Agility Tunnels Novice Championship Qualifier

This class will count as one heat of the qualifying rounds and there are multiple qualifying heats throughout 2024.

The three highest placed dogs, in Grade 1, in each sections qualify for the final in July. Points will be awarded to all other placings and clear rounds. Additional finalists will be drawn from the points table.

Only grade 1 dogs may qualify for the finals. Any dogs who may have qualified whilst Grade 1 but since graded up into grade 2 will still be invited to run in the finals.

Naylor Agility Tunnels Open Championship Qualifier

This class will count as one heat of the qualifying rounds and there are multiple qualifying heats throughout 2024.

The three highest placed dogs in each sections qualify for the final in July. Points will be awarded to all other placings and clear rounds. Additional finalists will be drawn from the points table.

Only grade 2, 3 and 4 dogs may qualify for the finals. Any dogs who may have qualified whilst in one grade but since graded up will still be invited to run in the finals.

QUALIFIERS FOR 2024 FINALS

HOOKEDONHOOPERS.COM Speedstakes Qualifier

This class will count as one heat of the qualifying rounds. There are multiple qualifying heats throughout 2024 and the dogs who have accumulated the most points once all heats have been run will be invited to the finals in July. This is a specials class and is open to any grade of dog.



PawsMade Pairs Qualifier

This class will count as one heat of the qualifying rounds. There are multiple qualifying heats throughout 2024 and the pairs who have accumulated the most points once all heats have been run will be invited to the finals in July. This is a specials class and is open to any grade of dog. A dog/handler may run in more than one Pairs partnership throughout the year.
